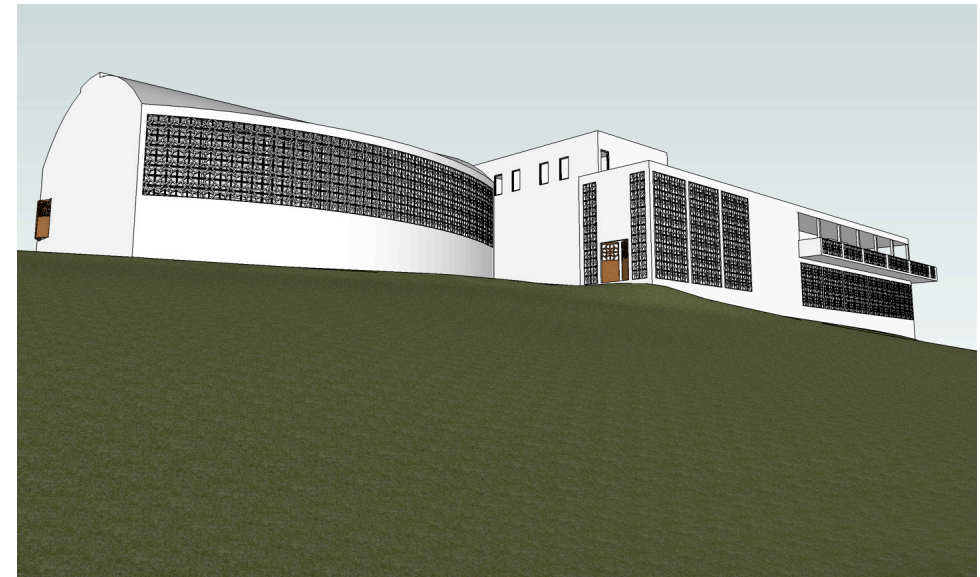
Level One

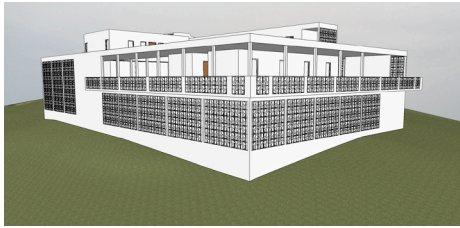

## Ministry Background

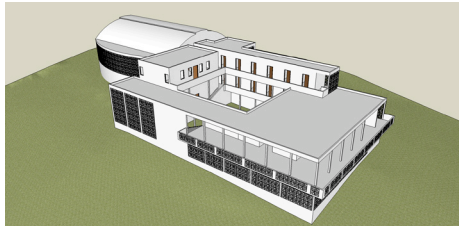
Doorway to Peace, Inc., is an evangelical Christian organization devoted to ministering to the spiritual and physical needs of the people of Haiti. Its missionary outreach is mainly conducted in the southwest part of Haiti in a village known as Faugasse, which neighbors the city of Les Cayes. The goals of Doorway to Peace are: to effectively minister the gospel of Jesus Christ in both word and deed to the people of Faugasse, Haiti and the surrounding region; to equip Christian leaders in the area for more effective ministry; and to strategically invest in community development projects to improve the physical, social and educational welfare of the people in Faugasse and neighboring communities.

## Mount Zion Prayer Center

Like much of Haiti, Faugasse is stricken with poverty and affected by the strong practice of Voodoo and witchcraft. The prayer center will be a gathering place for local, national, and international intercessors who can pray twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. The vision of Mount Zion Prayer Center is the liberation of Haiti from its satanic dedication which has hindered the progress of outreach ministries. Through constant intercession, the center will act as a beacon and a catalyst of spiritual change in the community.

## Prayer Hall & Room

The main function of the project is to create a combination of enclosed and open spaces that create both a sense of intimacy and community during private and communal prayer sessions. The Prayer Room is capable of accommodating 20 persons and the Prayer Hall 200 persons. As the client anticipates the future need of accommodating up to 500 persons for prayer events, the Prayer Hall's open plan allows overflow to occur into the courtyard. The natural slope of the courtyard doubles as an amphitheatre, a conducive environment for the facilitation of communal events. The Prayer Hall and Prayer Room have external walls of decorative ventilation blocks which also allow strategic views of Les Cayes and Faugasse.

## Conference Room

A large space was requested for holding conferences at which international speakers can teach and train Haitian locals to pray. Located at the opposite end of the complex from the Prayer Hall and Room, potential interruptions caused by simultaneous use of the two functional areas will be minimized.

## Staff Hostel

As the ministry is planning to have DTP staff visiting the area regularly, permanent accommodation, comprising of four bedrooms and a shared living area, is provided.

## Guest Accommodation

The flow of visitors staying overnight for conferences and prayer will be accommodated in bunk-style bedrooms designed to house four persons each. These rooms can also be used as administrative spaces if required by the ministry's future needs. Communal Washroom facilities will be provided

## Administrative Space

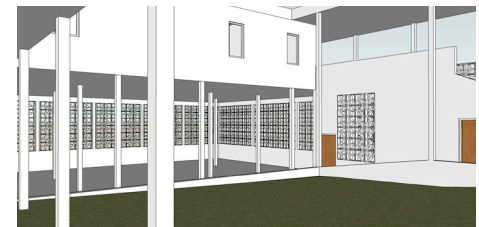
A group of eight rooms will be made available as ministry spaces for specific village prayer and strategic mapping.

## Service Spaces

Service spaces required for the primary functions of the building include: mechanical room, washrooms, and communal dining area. The communal hall is centrally located and able to facilitate approximately fifty people.
